I remember being told that I needed to find an ABA program everywhere I went, but the more I read about it the more I knew I didn't want to go in that direction. It gave us hope, clarity and a clear approach that felt right, that was aligned with the respect and the appreciation of what every kid has to offer and how valuable they are as they are! We learned to unlock the door to be able to join our son in his world, his interests and learn to followed his lead. Years later, my daughter got the same diagnosis and we felt supported and empowered by this incredible team.

As a family we are really grateful for having the opportunity to learn from Jake. His knowledge, empathy, passion to help others and the support he provides has truly made a difference for us.

My oldest son is doing great at school, has established meaningful friendships and he is absolutely thriving. My youngest has become more flexible after visiting the FTC in December and by implementing the Greenspan Floortime approach at home during the last couple of months we are seeing her flourish and overcome a lot of obstacles establishing relations at school. She is more able to express her needs instead of keeping it to herself until she faced big emotions and meltdowns, face challenges that she would avoid and explore new social interactions feeling confident while doing so.
